## WHO WE ARE

You are currently sitting in what used to be the most impoverished neighborhood in North Waco. Next door was an "adult" theater, across the street was a liquor store, and all around was poverty. In 1978, down the street from all of this, a Baylor graduate couple moved in. Jimmy and Janet Dorrel came with one goal, to love their neighbors. They began to get to know those living around them and invited the neighborhood kids over to their house. In 1991, after several years of unofficial neighborhood ministry, the couple, with much help from Christian Mission Concerns, founded the nonprofit **Mission Waco**. Since its humble beginnings, Mission Waco has grown to over 20 programs serving the homeless, poor, and marginalized all around Waco; one, of which, you are participating in right now.

**World Cup Cafe** had its grand opening on February 14th, 2006 as a way to bring economic development and job opportunities into the community as well as provide a place where people of all different backgrounds and socioeconomic status could gather.
