OUR ARTISAN OF THE MONTH: QUERIDA MIA BAGS

We met the Artisan at No Need Among You in Fort
Worth last Fall. He was weaving in the booth next to us.
Over the next few days, through Google Translate and
one of our Mission Waco staff, we learned about him
and his incredible story. He was arrested and
imprisoned after saving his sister from a domestic
abuse situation. During his 8 months in prison, he
learned how to make these incredible bags. After he
was released, he was encouraged to use his new found
skill to provide for his family. He took a leap of faith and
started Querida Mia. He now employs others from his
village in Puebla, Mexico, including the widow who lines
each bag. After a bout with Covid leaving her lungs
severely scarred, she now can stay at home and provide
for her family making the linings.
